Rebecca was born into the Bouvier world and her life long focus has been on the betterment of the breed. Her mother, Judith Allen of Joy-A-Len Kennels, began breeding Bouviers in 1969. At the age of five, Rebecca chose her own puppy, Am/Can CH Joy-A-Len's Saucie Sally. She proceeded to show Sally herself and obtained both American and Canadian championships. Since that time her love of the Bouvier has grown and after being very involved with her mother's Bouvier breeding program as a teenager, she started her own breeding program (Robbins Bouviers) in 2005. Starting as a junior exhibitor, she has continued to successfully show many dogs over the last 35+ years to finish their American, Canadian, and UKC championships, with several dogs earning titles in the following of all three venues: conformation, obedience, agility, draft dog, barn hunt, and is currently involved with Therapy Dog work. Rebecca has bred and owned the first and second Bouvier to obtain combined Grand Champion status in AKC, CKC, and UKC - Robbins Majestic Serenade, and Robbins Majestic Prince Charming respectively. Since 2005, she has also had a Top 20 qualifier in conformation and performance.. With her 25+ years of Bouvier breeding experience, she continues to make temperament and health her main priority

Representing Multi Breed Judges

Dr. Vandra L. Huber has been involved in the sport of purebred dogs for more than 35 years. Under the Kennel name of McVan®, she and her husband Michael Krolewski have bred more than 125 American champions and 50 Canadian champions. Her Scottish Terriers have garnered national specialty honors in the USA and Canada and have gone Best in Show at Crufts and the Westminster Kennel Club. Additionally, she has had top ranking Scottish Terriers in Canada, Australia, Thailand and Singapore. She currently owns the top specialty winning Scottish Terrier of all time.

Dr. Huber also has owned and bred several other terrier breeds, namely smooth and wire fox terriers, border terriers, cairn terrier,

miniature schnauzer, as well as an affenpincher, bearded collie, wire-haired dachshunds and a miniature poodle. The poodle was No. 1 when it was shown in Canada. She is a preservation breeder who attempts to breed dogs that exemplify the standard. She is an AKC breeder of Merit and a Mentor for the Scottish Terrier Club of America.

Dr. Huber is licensed by the American Kennel Club to judge all terriers, the toy group, all poodles, numerous herding breeds bearded collies, and miniature schnauzers. She has judged Scottish Terrier national specialties in Japan, Germany and the United States. Internationally, she also has judged in Australia, China, Denmark, Norway, Sweden (World Terrier Show), Thailand, Finland, Latvia and Russia. Vandra is passionate about the sport of purebred dogs and enjoys traveling internationally to judge.

After a 35 year career in academics, Dr. Huber is now an emeritus professor of Human Resources and Management at the Foster Business School at the University of Washington, Seattle, WA. She currently consults and serves as an expert witness on human resources issues. She is the author of several textbooks and more than 50 academic articles. An avid world traveler, she was a Fulbright Scholar in Thailand and has been a Visiting Professor at Korea University. She also led student study groups to India, South Africa, and Peru and worked on a humanitarian project in Uganda.

Representing Professional Handlers

I have been involved in pure bred dogs my entire life. I am a third generation dog person. As a young person I would work for my dad (Wood Wornall) during the summers and any weekends he needed help. After school I worked professionally as a hunter jumper trainer, but dogs were always in my blood. Eventually I returned to the dog world working full time for my dad. When he retired myself, my husband Christian Rangel, and Andrew Peel took over the business. I have shown many best in show winners from the hound, terrier, toy, non sporting and herding groups. I won best in show at Montgomery Co in 2007 the biggest terrier show in the world. Together with my husband I breed pointers. And together with my mom I breed cavalier King Charles Spaniels. I am honored to have been asked to judge your top 20 as yours is a breed I have always been fond of. I truly look forward to this evening.
